Attached you can find a pdf which briefly presents how Columbi's tool provides you with a useful current situation analysis. Presentations are all well and good, but I fully understand that you are curious about how this works and you want to give it a try.

Before you click on the link below, I ask you to keep in mind that this situation is a bit special. Normally, all the participants in the group that is going to carry out the Columbi assessment have received an invitation explaining the purpose and objectives of it. They have also been told how the materials will be reported back, e.g. "at the meeting on the 15th we will discuss the results and how we go on from here".

Now you are taking part in a demo and everything is "for real" except for the fact that the purpose is to give you the opportunity to try it out, rather than to create a current situation analysis of your team. However, please do try to consider yourself in your current work situation, answer "for real".

All Columbi assessments are anonymous. We do not see what you answer, we do not even see that you have tested the assessment! We only see that we have received a new response - so you can test it several times over, or show it to a colleague, that's absolutely fine!
